



Only on One Condition!

Hello from the vertical of Coding Gliders from Wings N' Sky. In this first Article, we will be discussing Conditions in Python!

Now, I understand, the first thing that might(and most probably will) come into your head would be the snake. But honestly, you should think of Python (the coding language) like a snake, because, coding and problemsolving can be one! Don't say you weren't warned!!

Python is a dynamic(coding) language, emphasizing readability. And speaking of problem-solving, one of the most important tools to help you solve problems are: *Conditions*.

Before we jump to the syntax*, we must learn the concept. Always remember - concept comes first!
All right, so conditions in programming world work in a similar fashion as they do in the real world. For e.g., suppose it's the rainy season. Whenever we are going out, our mind might repeatedly check the same condition —

If it is raining outside, wear a raincoat and gumboots and carry an umbrella.

Let's try to express this in Python.

```
if weather == "rainy":
    print("Wear a raincoat
    and gumboots and carry
    an umbrella.")
```

The condition weather == "rainy" will evaluate to 'True' if it's raining, and False otherwise. The == is the operator we use to compare two things. We won't go into the details of the syntax yet, but we will sure do that in one of the future issues of Airborne. There are other operators too, and the values we compare also might be of different types.

We've learned about if statements. But rainy isn't the only weather. Sunny, cloudy, and snowy are just a few more examples. But how to write it? If you use if statements, again and again, it can be confusing and exhausting, and might not be able to give you desired results sometimes.

Elif (Else If) comes to the rescue!! What Elif does is, if the first if statement is not true, then the next condition is checked, if that's true, the following code block is executed and run.

And hey presto!! You've learnt elif!

Now before we say goodbye, there's still one, just one tiny little thing I want to share with you.

Else. An Else statement would say, if all of the conditions in the if-elif chain are false, then do this as a last resort. Let's add an example to the above code.

if weather == "rainy":
      print("Wear a raincoat
      and gumboots and carry
      an umbrella.")
    elif weather == "sunny":
      print("Just take an
      umbrella")
    elif weather == "stormy":
      print("Umm... shouldn't
      you stay inside?")
    # include all the other
    weather conditions you can
    think of!
    else:
10
      print("Strange weather
11
      conditions you have!")
```

So, in an if-elif-else structure, you would have one if statement, multiple or no elifs, and you may choose to include one else statement in the end.




Best Breakfast Options

And Being Aware!

Have you noticed a translucent, generally small image placed on images, documents, and in videos? Sometimes it will be followed by ©, the symbol of copyright. These are watermarks. So what are these watermarks? And why are they spoiling the images, videos for us? Let us find out.

Watermarks are stamp of ownership. It might consist of the logo or the name of the creator or the owner of the image. The owner has put it on the image (or video) which might be for preview purposes, so someone else can't steal and claim it as their own.

For example, in the new year ecard by uvgreetings.com below (Happy New Year by the way), right in the centre, overlapping the word New, is the watermark. It says ©UV Associates. Don't worry, we have taken permission from the website owner, we don't believe in stealing.

Even when you don't see a watermark, don't assume the image or video to be free. Always check the license. We will talk about the copyrights and various licences in our upcoming issues.
